UGC (MINIMUM STANDARDS OF INSTRUCTION FOR THE GRANT OF THE FIRST DEGREE THROUGH FORMAL EDUCATION) REGULATIONS, (FIRST AMENDMENT), 2007

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (f) of sub-section (1) of Section 26 of the UGC Act, 1956 (No. 3 of 1956) the University Grants Commission makes the following amendment Regulations, namely :

1. Short title, application and commencement :

- 1.1. These Regulations may be called the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards of Instruction for the Grant of the First Degree through Formal Education) Regulations (First Amendment), 2007.
- 1.2. These shall apply to all universities established or incorporated by or under a Central Act, a Provincial Act, or a State/Union Territory Act, and all institutions recognized by or affiliated to such Universities and all institutions deemed to be universities under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956.
- 1.3. These shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

1st Amendment

The following clause 4.5 shall be added under Section 4 of the UGC (Minimum Standards of Instruction for the Grant of the First Degree through Formal Education) Regulations, 2003 :—

"4.5 Every university shall ensure that the classes for courses in subjects other than professional courses for the first year students shall commence by not later than the first week of August and for the students of second year onwards, by not later than the third week of July. The results for all the courses shall be declared by not later than last week of June.

A flexibility of upto two weeks may be allowed for professional courses in commencement of classes for students of 2nd year and later keeping in view the requirement of project work, summer schools and internship, etc. in professional courses."

विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग अधिनियम 1956 (1956 की संख्या 3) की धारा 26 की उपधारा (1) के अनुच्छेद (एफ) द्वारा प्रदत्त अधिकारों का प्रयोग करते हुए विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग निम्नलिखित संशोधन विनियम बनाता है। ये हैं :-

संक्षिप्त नाम प्रयोग और प्रारंभ

- 1.1 ये विनियम विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग (औपचारिक शिक्षा के माध्यम से परास्नातक (मास्टर्स) प्रदान करने संबंधी निर्देशों के न्यूनतम मानक) विनियम, (प्रथम संशोधन), 2007 कहलायेंगे।
- 1.2 ये विनियम उन सभी विश्वविद्यालयों पर लागू होंगे जिनकी स्थापना अथवा समावेश (विनियम) किसी केन्द्रीय कानून, किसी प्रांतीय कानून या राज्य/केन्द्र शासित प्रदेश के कानून के तहत की गई हो और ऐसे विश्वविद्यालयों द्वारा मान्यता प्राप्त या उनसे सम्बद्ध सभी संस्थानों और विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग कानून, 1956 की धारा 3 के अन्तर्गत समकक्ष विश्वविद्यालय माने गए संस्थानों पर भी लागू होंगे।
- 1.3 ये विनियम अपने सरकारी राजपत्र में प्रकाशित होने की तिथि से लागू हो जाएँगे।

प्रथम संशोधन

विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग (औपचारिक शिक्षा के माध्यम से परास्नातक (मास्टर्स) प्रदान करने संबंधी न्यूनतम मानक) विनियम 2003 के धारा 4 के अन्तर्गत निम्नलिखित धारा 4.5 जोड़ी जाएगी।

- 4.5 प्रत्येक विश्वविद्यालय यह सुनिश्चित करेगा कि व्यावसायिक पाठ्यक्रमों को छोड़कर अन्य विषयों के पाठ्यक्रमों की कक्षाएँ अगस्त माह के प्रथम सप्ताह तक शुरू कर दी जाएँगी और दूसरे और उसके बाद के वर्षों के छात्रों के लिए कक्षाएँ जुलाई के तीसरे सप्ताह तक शुरू हो जानी चाहिए। सभी पाठ्यक्रमों के परिणाम जून के अंतिम सप्ताह तक घोषित हो जाएँगे।

व्यावसायिक पाठ्यक्रमों के परियोजना कार्य, ग्रीष्मकालीन विद्यालयों और प्रशिक्षु काल की आवश्यकताओं को देखते हुए इन पाठ्यक्रमों के लिए द्वितीय और उसके बाद के वर्षों के कक्षाओं को शुरू करने के कार्यक्रम की समय-सीमा में दो सप्ताह तक की छूट दी जा सकती है।

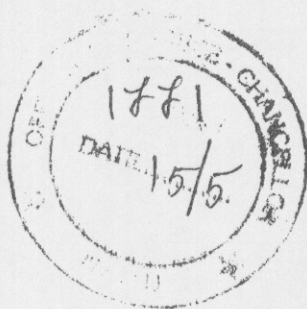

<p>1. Short Title: There shall be established Correspondence Courses under the Centre for Distance Education, North-Eastern Hill University.</p> <p>2. Objectives: (i) The objective of the Correspondence Courses shall be to offer courses at Post Graduate level to students who have, for some reason or other, been deprived of higher education. (ii) The number of courses under the Programme will be decided by the Competent Authority from time to time.</p> <p>3. Eligibility : Any Graduate</p> <p>4. Standing Committee: There shall be a Standing Committee for the purpose. The composition of the Committee shall be as follows:</p> <p>(i) Director / Head of the Centre for Distance Education as ex-officio Convener and Member-Secretary.</p> <p>(ii) Head of the concerned Department as ex-officio Chairman.</p> <p>(iii) One Professor and one Reader of the relevant subject of the Post-Graduate Department, NEHU as members in order of seniority.</p> <p>(iv) One Professor from a cognate subject to be nominated by the Dean of the concerned School.</p> <p>(v) One subject expert at the Professor level preferably from North-Eastern region as a member to be nominated by the Vice-chancellors, NEHU, Shillong.</p>	<p>1. Objective: The objective of distance mode of education shall be to offer need based courses to students who are desirous of further education through various modes of distance learning systems.</p> <p>2. Eligibility: The eligibility of admission, duration of courses and fees etc. shall be provided in regulations for each course / programme as and when offered.</p> <p>3. Course Structure: (a) The syllabus of each of the courses shall be the same for M.A/M.Ed/M.Sc/M.Com/MBA etc. for disciplines that University operates masters programmes.</p> <p>(b) The syllabus for other U.G. Degree, Diploma or Certificate courses shall be prepared by respective Expert Committee that may be constituted by the Vice-Chancellor on recommendation of the Head of Centre for Distance education or adopted by the University.</p> <p>© The syllabus such framed or adopted may be considered by the Steering Committee of the Centre which shall recommend the same to the Chairperson of an appropriate School Board of School of Studies that may consider the syllabus and recommend to the Academic Council for its approval. <p>vi) Controller of Examinations or his nominee.</p> <p>5. Term of Office: The term of office of the members except that of the Head/Director, Centre for Distance Education, NEHU, Shillong and the Head of the concerned Department, shall be for a period of three years.</p> <p>6. Quorum: A minimum of three members shall constitute the quorum, provided the convener and the Head of the concerned subject are present. The Standing Committee shall meet as and when required subject to a minimum of twice a year.</p> <p>7. Function of the Committee: The function of the Standing Committee will be as laid down in the regulations.</p> <p>8. Course Structure:(i) The syllabus of the subject offered would be the same as a regular course offered in the University (ii) The examination for the correspondence course shall be at the end of the second and fourth semesters and not at the end of each semester as in the case of regular courses. (iii) A candidate registering for a Post-Graduate course under the programme may have a maximum of 5 years to complete and be eligible for the degree and those failing to complete and pass the course within the stipulated time of 5 years, will have to seek fresh admission. (iv) Each course in the Programme will carry 100 marks for each paper. There shall be no sessional assessment, field work or dissertation. (v) There shall be separate questions paper of 100 marks for each paper.</p> <p>9. Procedure of Admission and Fees: The procedure of Admission and fees shall be as laid down in the regulations.</p>	<p>Academic Council for its consideration.</p> <p>4. Examination: The examinations for the courses offered shall be conducted by the University and as per modalities provided in regulations for the purpose.</p> <p>5. **REGULATION ON B.ED (SPECIAL EDUCATION); B.Ed. - SEDE
(Under Ordinance , on Distance Mode of Education)**

- 1. The Programme of Study:** The Centre for Distance Education, NEHU will offer a Bachelor of Education Programme on Special Education in collaboration with Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI), ordinarily for students from the North East India. The candidates on successful completion of the course shall be eligible to receive a degree of B.Ed. - SEDE from the University.
- 2. Objective:** Objective of the B.Ed Special Education Programme is to equip the candidates with knowledge and skills in the field of managing and educating persons 'differently abled' as required for the Programme.
- 3. Duration:** The duration of the Programme shall be 2 years. Students can complete the course within 5 years.
- 4. Medium of Instruction:** The medium of instruction shall be English.
- 5. Eligibility of Enrolment:** The Applicant should:
- (a) have a Bachelor Degree from any UGC recognized University; and
 - (b) fulfill any one of the following conditions:
 - (i) be a parent of a differently abled child,
 - (ii) be a differently abled person,
 - (iii) possess of a RCI recognized Diploma in Special Education (DSE),
 - (iv) have undergone Bridge Course of RCI,
 - (v) have completed the RCI recognized Foundation Course (FC -SEDE),
 - (vi) have a minimum of two years experience in managing and educating persons 'differently abled' in a special school environment, after his / her graduation.

- 6. Selection for Admission:** As per policy of the University, from time to time.
- 7. Fee:** (A) Application fee – R.600/-; (B) Course Fee – Rs.15000/- payable at the time of admission. It may be revised from time to time.
- 8. Course:** The Course structure and methods of evaluation will be prescribed in the syllabus for the purpose.
- 9. Collaboration with RCI:** In view of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) signed between the North Eastern Hill University (NEHU) and Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI), both the parties will consult and assist in operation of the programme for its successful implementation.
