Sub: Appeal from some teachers of P.G. Departments of Mizoram
Campus for relocation of P.G. Departments in pursuance of
E.C resolutions.

Sir,

You may be aware that the Mizoram University (MU) Bill was passed in the last session of parliament, and has been notified vide Gazette Notification of Government. As per provisions Laid down in clause 33 (I) of the said Act, all employees of NEHU working in the Mizoram Campus (MC) shall be deemed to have been transferred to the services of the MU from its date of implementation. In this context, we had earlier appraised you of the situation through our representations, wherein, we had requested your attention to the implementation of the recommendations of the committee for relocation of the P.G. departments of M.C. to Tura and Shillong campuses. As per the resolutions, the departments of Forestry, Geology & Psychology were to be shifted to Hqrs. at Shillong and the rest to the Tura Campus.

In your capacity as the Chairman of the highest body of NEHU, we, once again, earnestly request you to honour the decision of the EC, and take appropriate steps to ensure that we are relocated to the respective campuses before the implementation of the MU Act and commencement of the new University.

Besides, as members of the faculty, we feel it appropriate to point out that in the larger interests of the University in particular and the state in general, and keeping in mind the stringent financial measures adopted by the Centre, we apprehend that the possibility of further diversification of the campuses will not be possible, at least not within the coming decade. Under the circumstances, the Tura campus will be the worst suffer. At this juncture therefore, it will be prudent to relocate the P.G. departments of the MC and consolidate the Hqrs and campus, rather than lose an already existing infrastructure. Towards this end, the EC resolutions can be an effective instrument provided the will to implement it is there.

We hope that the facts laid down above will be convincing enough to elicit a positive response from your end.

Considering the urgency of the matter, we request you to include it as an agenda item of the EC meeting slated for the 13th of July, 2000.
