

(vii) Extension of deputation of Sri. Chhawnvunga Lecturer, Pachhunga University College.

Sri. Chhawnvunga Lecturer English Department Pachhunga University College was released on deputation with effect from 14/4/94 (AN) to join as Liaison Officer NSS Cell under Department of Sports and Youth Service Government of Mizoram for a period of two years as approved by the EC, in its meeting held on 29/3/94 vide EC decision NO:EC:82:94:03: (ix). Subsequently the term was further extended for another period of one year with effect from 15/4/96 and approved by the EC resolution NO:EC:90:96:3:(iv). On receipt of the request of under Secretary Government of Mizoram, Sports and Youth Service and request from Chief Minister of Mizoram Govt. and with No due certificate from the Principal Pachhunga University College another period of one year with effect from 15-4-97 was granted which expired on 14/4/98. The Secretary to the Government of Mizoram vide his letter dt. 1-5-98 (anexure 1) has again requested for another extension of 1(one) year from 15/4/98 along with the willingness of Sri. Chhawnvunga. dt. 1-5-98 does not specify that the service of Sri. Chhawnvunga is in the Public interest.

The case was referred to the Principal, Pachhunga University College for his comments. The Principal in his reply dt. 16/6/98 at (anexure II) has stated that the earlier extension granted for 1 one year with effect from 15/4/97 - 14-4-98 is already in excess of the permissible period and has not agreed to issue any No objection certificate for further extension. In term of G O I rules on deputation at anexure (III) of clause 8 3 1 the extension of deputation period for the 5th year or the 2nd year in excess of the said prescribed in the recruitment rules can be accorded in cases where it is absolutely necessary and in rare and exceptional circumstances and strictly in public interest.

EXTRACT FROM THE F.R. S.RTENURE OF DEPUTATION

8.1. The period of deputation shall be subject to a maximum of three years in all cases except for those posts where a longer period of tenure is prescribed in the Recruitment.

8.2. The Administrative Ministries may grant extension beyond this limit up to one year, after obtaining orders of their Secretary, in cases where such extension is considered necessary in public interest.

8.3. The borrowing Ministries/Departments may extend the period of deputation for the Fifth year or for the second year in excess of the period prescribed in the Recruitment Rules, where absolutely necessary subject to the following conditions:-

(i) While according extension for the Fifth or the Second year or in excess of the period prescribed in the Recruitment Rules, the directive issued for rigid application of the tenure rules should be taken into consideration only in real and exceptional circumstances, such extension should be granted.

(ii) The extension should be strictly in public interest and with the specific prior approval of the concerned Minister in the borrowing Ministry/Department.

(iii) Where such extension is granted it would be on the specific understanding that the officer would not be entitled to draw deputation (duty) allowance.

(iv) The extension would be subject to the prior approval of the lending organisation of the officer on deputation and wherever necessary, the U.P.S.C.
