

- (ii) Raising the retirement age from 60 years to 62 years in respect of officers Group 'A'

The 100th Executive Council meeting had considered the cut off date of the age of superannuation of 62 years in respect of teachers and resolved that the same be 62 years, taking the 6.11.98 letter as a continuation of 27.7.98 letter on the subject. The Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development (Department of Education) vide letter No.F.1-49/98-U.I dated 21.4.99 (annexure-I) has enhanced the retirement age from the existing 60 years to 62 years in respect of teachers and Registrar/Jt. Registrar/Dy. Registrar/Asstt. Registrar/Librarian/Director of Physical Education/Dy. Librarian/Asstt. Librarian/Dy. Director of Physical Education/Asstt. Director of Physical Education/Finance Officer/Controllers of Examinations whose age of superannuation was 60 years prior to issue of the Notification dated 27.7.98/6.11.98.

In view of the above, the cut off date of the enhanced superannuation age from 60 years to 62 years has been taken as on 27.7.98 in respect of teachers and applicable officers as specified in the Ministry's letter dated 21.4.99.

The matter is therefore, placed before the Council for approval of the enhancement of the superannuation age of the officers mentioned above.
