

6:6: Service conditions/Financial & other Benefits.

(i) Change of wording in Deeds of agreement.

The Pachhunga University College was taken over by the University with effect from 19/4/79 by a Deed of Agreement between NEHU and the Government of Mizoram (anexure 1) under Clause - 18 wherein it was stated that the teaching and non-teaching staff of Pachhunga University College who opt for Mizoram service after taking over of the College by the University will be on deputation with the University without deputation allowance till such time as the Government can arrange suitable posts for their absorption in the service of Government. In absence of any foreign contribution to the Government of Mizoram, the Government is facing the difficulty in processing the case of (L) Sri V.Chuanghmingthanga who opted for Mizoram service. He was released from PUC on 3/2/87 (fornoon) to join his parent department after remaining in PUC from 19/4/79 to 2/2/87. A copy of the Under Secretary to the Government of Mizoram vide letter No.ECL/PF/47/76 dated 21/4/99 and also that of the Joint Secretary letter dt.22Feb. 99 is placed below at (anexure II & III) Strictly speaking if the staff are treated on deputation, they are to be covered by the deputation terms and allowances for which the foreign contributions is to be paid by NEHU. But considering the circumstances under which the staff have been put on deputation without deputation allowance and as the Government of Mizoram vide letter No ECL/PF/47/76 dt. 21/4/99 (anexure II) has not insisted for payment of foreign contribution, perhaps their request for substitution the term "deputation with the University without deputation allowances to "on duty" may be considered.

This would facilitate early settlement of retirement benefits in respect of Sri.V.Chuanghmingthanga(L) and others who have opted for Mizoram Government services as NEHU will not be liable to pay the foreign contribution.

In view of the above the matter is placed before the Executive for consideration/decision.

Sir,

In inviting a reference to the letters cited above, I have the honour to state that the difficulties expressed by the Principal Pachhunga University College to accept the claim made by the Deputy Director (ENT) for release of an amount towards payment of pension and leave salary contributions to Government of Mizoram in favour of Pu V. Chuangmingthanga (L) appears to be genuine for the following reasons.

1. The deputation of Pu V.Chuangmingthanga(L) to NEHU was carried out not on the basis of a request made by the University but because the Government did not have suitable post to absorb him immediately after the Pachhunga University College was handed over to University (Deeds of Agreement, Clause No. 18).
2. Seperate deputation order with terms and conditions was not served to Pu V.Chuangmingthanga (L). Also no provision for pension and leave salary contribution was included in the Deeds of Agreement.

In this connection, mention may also be made that the cases of the following persons shall be given similar treatment with that of Pu V.Chuangmingthanga (L) as their services on deputation to University are governed by the same Deeds of Agreement. It is, therefore, desired that the case of each incumbent shall be jointly taken up to avoid possible complicity.
