

iv) Qualifications of University teachers.

In pursuance of the UGC Notification of 24th Dec, 1993, appopos to the 5th pay Revision, the Council has laid down the following qualifications for the post of Lecturer vide resolution No:EC:103:99:5:1(iii).

Lecturer 4.A. In Humanities, Social Sciences, Sciences Education Physical Education Law, Foreign Languages.

- i) A good academic record with at least 55% marks or grade E in the 7 point Scale of letter Grade O,A,B,C,D,E.F, at the Master's degree level in the relevant subject from an Indian University established by law or an equivalent degree from a recognised Foreign University.
- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, a candidate for lectureship in any of the subjects specified above should have either a Ph D degree in the subject concerned or should have cleared the National Eligibility Test(NET) for lectureship conducted by UGC, CSIR

Now, the commission vide D O No:F.3-1/2000(DS) of 4th April'2000 has intimated that the option given to the University for selection of either NET or Ph.D Candidates has been withdrawn and NET only shall remain the compulsory requirement for appointment as Lecturer even for candidates having Ph D Degree. However, the candidates who have completed M Phil degree or have submitted Ph D thesis in the concerned subject up to 31st December'1993 are exempted from appearing in the NET examination. A copy of the said D O Letter is placed as Annexure-'A' for favour of perusal by the Council.

The above matter was placed before the Academic Council in its 64th meeting wherein the Council resolved to accept the same.

Sub : UGC Regulations on minimum qualifications for appointment and for Career Advancement of Lecturers, Readers and Professor in the Universities & Colleges.

Dear Sir/Madam,

In supersession of UGC Regulation No:F.1-11/87(CPP-II) dated 19th September,1991 and Notification No.F.3-1/94(PS) dated 24 December,1998,the UGC has made the Regulations for minimum qualifications required for the appointment and career advancement of teachers in Universities and institutions affiliated to it.

The Regulations have been sent to Assistant Controller (Commercial),Government of India, Department of Publication, (Urban Development and Employment)Civil Lines, Delhi, for Publication in the Gazette of India.

The provision contained in the UGC Notification of 24th December,1998 mentioning that it would be optional for the university to exempt Ph.D degree holders from NET or to require NET in their case as a desirable or essential qualification for appointment as lecturer has been withdrawn. NET shall remain the compulsory requirement for appointment as Lecturer even for candidates having Ph D degree.However, the candidates who have completed M.Phil degree or have submitted Ph.D thesis in the concerned subject up to 31st December,1993, are exempted from appearing in the NET examination.

The proviso in the Regulation,1991 which reads as follows:-

Provided that any relaxation in the prescribed qualifications can only be made by a University in regard to the Posts under it or any of the institutions including constituent or affiliated colleges recognised under clause (f) Section 2 of aforesaid Act or by an institution deemed to be a university under Section 3 of the said Act with the prior approval of the University Grants Commission.

has been dropped and is replaced by the following proviso :-

Provided that any relaxation in the prescribed qualifications can only be made by the University Grants Commission in a particular subject in which NET is not being conducted or enough number of candidates are not available with NET qualifications for a specified period only.(This relaxation if allowed would be given based on sound justification and would apply to affected Universities for that particular subject for the specified period. No individual applications would be entertained)
