With the introduction of Three Years Degree Integrated Course since 1994, the pattern of question papers for general pass course has been splitted two sections containing questions like Multiple choice, True or False and short answers.

The answers to the objective questions are required at the time of evaluation by the examiners and in order to have the answers readily available to expedite the process of evaluation, the paper setters are being requested to submit the answers to the the objective questions.

As the paper setting for general course itself is a strenous job and therefore it has been considered and approved by the Vice-Chancellor to pay a sum of Rs.100/-to the concerned paper setter as an incentive for preparation of answers to the objective questions in addition to the amount approved for paper setting.
