

EXAMINATION DEPARTMENT

The year 1999-2000, the year under report, has been a year of great satisfaction for the University. We had switched over from the annual system of examination to the Part I and Part II system of examinations of which the Part I examination is at the end of 2nd year and the Part II at the end of the third year of the TDC.

We are happy to report that, of the facts of statistics are any indication, the performances of the students have far improved. The statistics of results of 1999 and 2000 show that the performances of the students have largely increased. In fact, they were 55.76 (Hons) and 36.75 (Gen) in 1999 and in 2000 they were 64.77 and 42.92 respectively. This statistics show that we have been able to give maximum of classes to the students and that the Part I and Part II system of examination have proved superior to the earlier annual system of examination with repeat facilities.

The examination Department has meanwhile been shifted to the city at one place in Bijni Complex to the greater advantage of the students and the public. Now the students as well as public can have easier interface with the examination department and the department, being in one common place, geared up for great efficiency and achievements.

We are, also, happy to report that for the PG, M.Phil and Ph.D programmes we have been able to introduce necessary changes in the curriculum towards improvement in academic excellence. We are confident that changes, so inculcated, will enable us to bear better fruits in the years to come.
