

(vi) Proposal for enhancement of Hostel fees etc.

Considering the inflation rate the Dean Student Welfare has submitted a proposal for enhancement of hostel fees and other fees as at Annexure - 'A'.

The matter was placed before the 57th meeting of the Council considered the enhancement of Hostel rent from Rs.17/- to Rs.50/- and Hostel Caution deposit from Rs.200/- to Rs.500 and a new Hostel application Form fee of Rs.2/- and recreation Fund fee of Rs.200/- and RESOLVED to approve the same and further RESOLVED that the enhancement of the Students' Association Fund Fee from Rs.40/- to Rs.20/-, Student Aid Fund fee from Rs.20/- to 40/- and a new Recreation Fund fee for Rs.200/- per annum be discussed by the Dean, Students' Welfare with the students and the Chairman is authorised to take a decision on the matter, the above fees will be applicable only to the students enrolled from the 1998 academic session only.

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration

Item No.1 - Proposal to raise Hostel rent: The occupants of the University Halls of residence till date, pay an amount of Rs.17 per month as Hostel rent. This amount is proposed to be raised to Rs.50 per month as hostel rent. The proposed amount although very meagre in comparison to the inflation on electricity, water and establishment charges will be able to meet some of the expenses will at least help the University to combat the growing expenses for Hostel management.

Item No.2 - The amount of Caution deposit is also hereby proposed to be raised from Rs.200 to Rs.500 per occupant. Since this amount is refundable the students will not be agrieved on the amount proposed.

Item No.3 - Fee for Hostel Application form is a new proposal and amount of Rs.2 for each Hostel application form is proposed to be charged by the D.S.W. office and the amount raised will be at the disposal of the D.S.W. office to meet expenses for emergencies and other office expenses.

Item No.4 - The creation of a 'Recreation Fund' for students is also a new proposal to help students to tide over the demands on the purchase of items related to sports and games etc. The recreation fund is proposed to be fixed at Rs.200 per annum payable at one installment. This will serve as a special fund over and above the usual yearly allotment for sports and games and other recreation items.

(v) Proposal for policy decision in regard to holding of Seminars / Conference / Symposium etc.
