5:8:Others- (i) Officiating Headship

Sub-Clause 2 of Clause 6 of the NEHU Statute on Deans of Schools of Studies states that 'When the office of the Dean is vacant or when the Dean is by reason of illness, absence or any other cause, unable to perform the duties of his office, the duties of the office shall be performed by such person as the Vice-Chancellor may appoint for the purpose.'

But, Clause 7 of the NEHU Statute is silent on the functions of the Head of Department during leave period, etc. To avoid the Headship vacant during his/her leave, etc. it is necessary that similar arrangements as in the case of Dean as empowered by the clause 6 (2) of the Statute be made.

In this context the Dean School of Humanities and Education vide his letter (at annexure-I) has suggested that in fitness of things, the principle of seniority or rotation should be followed by the Head of the Department while putting somebody incharge of the Department during their absence.

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration.
