- (i) Inclusion of members from SC/ST Communities
in Selection Committees for Teaching posts -

The Ministry of Human Resource Development (Department of Education), New Delhi in its D.O. letter No.F.1-17/97-Desk(U) dated 30.11.98 (Annexure - I) has emphatically stated that a number of representations have been received from various quarters including members of Parliament that Selection Committees constituted for making recommendations for appointment to teaching posts do not have any member from the SC/ST communities. As such the interest of SC/ST candidates is not adequately watched.

The matter has been considered by the Ministry whereby it is felt that such Selection Committees should also have representatives from SC/ST communities. The Ministry is of the view that suitable measures including amendment of the relevant Statutes be accordingly considered.

At present, composition of Selection Committees for making recommendation for appointment to various posts of Professor, Reader, Lecturer are strictly in accordance with Statute 20(2) of the NEHU Act and Statutes (Annexure - II).

The matter is placed before the E.C. for consideration.

For the past some time we have been receiving a number of representations from various quaters including Members of Parliament to the effect that the Selection Committees constituted for making recommendations for appointments to the teaching posts do not have any representations of SC/ST communities and that the interest of SC/ST candidates is, therefore, not adequately watched.

2. This issue has been considered in the Ministry in detail. It is felt that the Selection Committee constituted by the University should also have representatives from SC/ST communities. You may, therefore, consider to take suitable measures including the amendment of the relevant Statutes regarding the SC/ST composition of various Selection Committees.
