

SCHEDULED CASTES/TRIBES

The main objective in setting up of the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes Cell in the University by the UGC in the later part of 1983 is to oversee and monitor the implementation of the Reservation Policy of the Government to the Weaker sections in the society, Viz., the SCs, STs and OBCs so as to bring their status at par with the rest of the country in the near future.

Since inception, the SC/ST Special Cell, is actively involved in performing its duties towards the goal of maximum possible reservation, as per the Government rules, i.e., in matter relating to admission and enrolment of students, admission in hostels and appointment of Teaching and Non-Teaching posts for candidates belonging to this category. The present percentages of reservation adopted by the University for these communities are mentioned below :

| III. Direct recruitment to posts in Group C & D | : 1% for SC and 44% for ST (for the state of Meghalaya).
45% for ST (for the state of Mizoram.) |

| V. Appointment of Lecturers | : 15% for SC and 7.5% for ST. |
| VI. Promotion | : 15% for SC and 7.5% for ST. |

Statistics showing the present position of representation of SC/ST in the University in admission and enrolment to Post-Graduate Courses during the year 85.65% (1344 students belonging to SC/ST out of the total of 1569 students). Hostel admission for SC/ST residents during the year is at 85.4%. Representation of SC/ST in hostels is shown in Annexure-I. Also, the position of SC/STs in Teaching posts as on 1.1.2000 stands at 32.7% and Non-Teaching Posts at 65.6%. The actual position of SCs/STs, category-wise is shown in Annexure - II & III respectively.

This year, the University is fortunate to have the U.G.C. Standing Committee comprising of Prof. A.K. Dhan, former V.C. (NEHU), Prof. Veer Singh, Chandigarh, Prof. Romanamma and Dr. A.K. Parate, Deputy Secretary, UGC to visit the University Campus from June 4th to 6th, 1999 to assess and review the work of the SC/ST Cell in matter of reservation for SC/STs in admission and appointments. The Committee, during its stay here met the teachers, students and the staff of SC/ST Cell to discuss various problems pertaining to implementation of the Reservation Policy of the Government for SC/STs and OBCs. On the recommendation of this UGC Visiting Team, the cent percent financial assistance for the Cell has been extended till the end of the IXth Plan and an additional amount of Rs.1,00,000 (Rupees One Lac) has been

sanctioned for (i) TA/DA for Field work, (ii) Data Collection, (iii) Analysis and evaluation of Statistical data and (iv) Computer and Printer.
