

- (v) Implementation of the Revised pay scales and allowances recommended by the 5th Central Pay Commission and accepted by the Government of India.

In pursuance of the recommendations of the Vth Pay Commission on the revised pay scales and allowances for the Central Government Employees belonging to various categories of posts in Group A, B, C & D services, the Government of India has issued notification regarding implementation of the Revised Pay Scales with effect from 1st January, 1996.

The Revised Pay Scales for the post carrying the present scales of pay in Groups B, C & D services extends to 34 (thirty four) core pay scale and of which, the following are the existing relevant pay scales applicable in the University which have been revised under the said 34 core pay scales:-

It may be mentioned here that the University is following the Central Pay Structure and Allowances, fringe benefits, Pension Rules and other Fundamental Rules of the Government of India which are applicable to the employees of the Central Government Organisations.

It is therefore, expedient that the aforementioned revised pay scales and all other allowances and consequential benefits which have been notified by the Government of India for the central government employees have to be adopted by the University for its non-teaching employees belonging to Groups B, C & D categories of posts pending any subsequent changes in the revised scales of pay by the U.G.C.

Albe-it, the U.G.C. has not notified the revised pay scales for the non-teaching employees of the Central Universities but on the strength of the communication received from the U.G.C. vide Annexure-I seeking particular of additional requirement of funds for extending the revised pay scales with effect from 1-1-1996, it is understood that the revised pay scales as notified by the Government of India will be applicable to the non-teaching employees of the University.

The matter is placed for consideration and orders on adoption of the revised pay scales and allowances.

However, implementation of the Vth Pay Revision will be subject to sanction of fund by the U.G.C.

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration and orders and adoption of the revised pay scales and allowances.
