PLANNING DEPARTMENT

The Planning Department is concerned with the upliftment of administrative function for the economic and educational development of the University. The University has already been taken the following steps for setting up of Faculty of Engineering and Management. separate committees have been constituted for Engineering and Management studies in the University.

The Engineering Committee has accepted the Project Report submitted by Ed.Cil., India Ltd. New Delhi which has also been placed and duly approved by various bodies of the University like AC/EC etc. Necessary steps have been taken for construction of building for the Faculty of Engineering, where work has been awarded and the construction work has started. The Committee has also selected a private building to hire for the purpose of Hostel, Classrooms and Faculty rooms are being allotted in existing Academic Buildings for the time being.

The University is starting B.Tech. Course in (i) Information Technology and (ii) Electronics and Communication Engineering from the Academic Session beginning in July-August, 2006. These courses shall be available under the School of Technology in the Shillong Campus.

The Department of Management is to start at Tura Campus, NEHU. This has also been duly approved by various bodies of the University. The Department of Management Studies shall start from July 2006 under the existing School of Economics, Management and Information Sciences with a scope of having a full fledged School of Management Studies in Tura Campus in future.

Steps have already been initiated under the Vision Plan for the establishment of a College of Technology at Jowai. The location may be at Modymmat village, near Jowai where 45 acres of land has been proposed to donated to NEHU by the Village Durbar. If UGC supports the college shall be developed in phased manner.
