

6:6: Service condition/Financial & other benefits :-

(iv) Proposal for condonation of the required educational qualification in respect of two peons appointed by the erstwhile NEHU, Nagaland Campus.

This case is regarding the appointment of the two peons viz :

1) Shri Amar Bahadur Thapa and 2) Smti Sita Chetri who were appointed w.e.f. 25.5.87 and 1.1.83 respectively by the erstwhile Nagaland Campus without prior approval of the Vice-Chancellor to the Selection Committee Minutes. Expost facto approval of the Vice-Chancellor could not be obtained at the appropriate time because the appointees lack the educational qualification for the post of peon and there was no mention in the Nagaland Campus Selection Committee Minutes about condonation of educational qualification. The prescribed educational qualification for the post of peon is 'Passed Class VIII, whereas the two incumbent are:

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| 1. Shri Amar Bahadur Thapa | (Passed Class VI(six) | Appointed as peon w.e.f. 25.5.87. |
| 2. Smti Sita Chetri | (Passed Class V(five) | Appointed as peon w.e.f. 1.1.83 |

Their lack of educational qualification was pointed out to the Nagaland Campus Office and clarification was sought regarding the S.C.Minutes not indicating condonation of qualification. No reply was received from the Nagaland Campus. Consequent upon the establishment of Nagaland University, the two incumbents have repatriated to NEHU and the problem regarding their questionable appointment remained unsolved.

In order to have their appointments settled and regularised, the matter was placed to the Selection Committee for condonation of the education qualification. The Selection Committee which met on 17.4.97 recommended the condonation of qualification allowed by the Nagaland Campus authority then, in view of the fact that the incumbents have repatriated to NEHU and their post being created as 'Personal'.

The matter is placed before the .E.C. for consideration and approval of condonation of qualification.

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On account of the lapse and irregularity committed by Shri WR Lyngdoh the Council RESOLVED to impose a minor penalty on him by withholding one increment of his pay for a period of one year only without cumulative effect in terms of Rule 11 Clause iv of the CCS CCA Rules on Disciplinary Proceedings. The withholding of increment takes effect from the date of increment accruing to Shri WR Lyngdoh ,AE, after the issue of the Punishment Order.

6:6: Service Condition/Financial & Other Benefits.

(i) Retirement on Invalid - Extension of Invalid Pension to Shri Barton Kharmalki, Gate-Keeper, Library Department.
