## ITEMS FROM THE CHAIR

- (i) **Notice to CIEFL to withdraw the un-utilised 15 acres of land allotted by NEHU in 2003.**

**EC:130:2007:8:(i):** The Council considered the allotment of 20 acres of land to the CIEFL in 2003 and noted that the Institute had utilized the land for construction of only one Administrative Building. Since the remaining area is required by the University for its own purposes the Council **RESOLVED** that a Notice be served to the CIEFL that the University shall withdraw 15 acres of the land allotted to the Institute.

- (ii) **Request for compensation of land for link road from NEHU to National Highway at the rate of Rs.110/- by the Village Dorbar, Mawiong.**

**EC:130:2007:8:(ii):** The Council was informed that the University had acquired some land from the Mawiong Village Dorbar belonging to private individuals for the purpose of linking the University Campus with National Highway No.37. As no clear guidelines were received from the Deputy Commissioner, East Khasi Hills, the University had paid a compensation of Rs.80/- (Rupees eighty) only per sq.ft. to the landowners. However, recently the University had received a clarification from the Deputy Commissioner's Office that the Government rate of the land acquired ranges from Rs.80/- (Rupees eighty) only to Rs.150/- (Rupees one hundred and fifty) only per sq.ft. Most of the land acquired by the University falls in the range of Rs.120/- (Rupees one hundred and twenty) only per sq.ft., however, on negotiations with the Village Dorbar and the landowners a sum of Rs.110/- (Rupees one hundred and ten) only and Rs.105/- (Rupees one hundred and five) only as per Annexure 'A' was agreed upon. The Council considered the matter and **RESOLVED** that an amount of Rs.110/- (Rupees one hundred and ten) only and Rs.105/- (Rupees one hundred and five) only per sq.ft. may be paid for the land acquired.


- (iii) **Absorption of Dr. AC Dubey, Reader in the Department of Economics, NEHU by the National Council of Applied Economic Research, New Delhi.**

**EC:130:2007:8:(iii):** The Council considered the request of NCAER, New Delhi, to absorb Dr. AC Dubey, Reader of the Department of Economics w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2007 and **RESOLVED** to approve the same and that he be released from the services of the University w.e.f. 31.07.2007.(AN).


