The Committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor examining the rules relating to the Executive Council Resolution No. EC:89:96:6:06(iii) of the 89th Executive Council meeting held on 8.3.96 met on 12.7.96 at 11.30 A.M. in OSD's Chamber.

The Committee considered the E.C. Resolution No. EC:89:96:6(6)(iii) for granting facility in the form of Study Leave with full pay and allowances to the Assistant Registrars to complete (undergo) P.G. courses in the relevant streams.

Secondly, the committee noted the essential qualification required for recruitment to Dy.Registrar post which should be 'A post graduate degree with at least 55% marks or its equivalent grade'.

The Committee recommended that the A.K. may be allowed to undergo for any P.G. Course in any discipline in which they are eligible for admission.

The Committee felt that the facility should be extended to the Section Officers and Dy.Registrar also in the University, since the same essential qualification is needed for being directly recruited to the next higher post.

The Committee further recommended the following restrictions should be imposed while granting permission to prosecute Post Graduate Study, so that there will be no disruption in the official work as a consequence:

- (i) Only 25p.c. of the strength of a particular grade should be granted the facility in one batch at one point of time.
- (ii) The applicants concerned must have completed five years service in his/her particular grade.
- (iii) This facility should be granted for 2(two) years only.
- (iv) The applicants are required to sign a Bond with the University as per Govt. of India Leave Rules.
- (v) On the event of unsuccessful completion of the course the incumbent will have to refund the salary drawn during the leave period and all other allowances prescribed in the Govt. of India Rules and the bond executed by the person concerned.
- (vi) Applicants for Study Leave in this respect shall have to serve at least 3(three) years with the University, after completion of the course of study.
- (vii) The applicant concerned should submit a periodical report relating to the progress of his/her study, from the Head of Academic Deptt. concerned of the University concerned.

- vi) Applicants for Study Leave in this respect shall have to serve at least 3 (three) years with the University after completion of the Course of study failing which he has to refund the leave salary to the University.
- vii) Study Leave shall be granted for prosecution of studies in the relevant stream.
