Dear Sir,

Kindly refer to d.o.letter No.F.10-1/2002-Desk(U) dated June 11,2001 from Shri Maharaj Kaw, then Secretary (Secondary & Higher Education) regarding provision of certain concessions for the words of Kashmiri Migrants in the matter of their admission to the educational institutions in other parts of the country during the academic session 2001-2002. As the situation in Kashmir has not changed much and Kashmiri migrants continue to face hardships it would be necessary to provide concessions to their words for their admission during the coming academic session also.

2. I have been directed to request you that Govt. of India have decided to provide following concessions to the Kashmiri migrant students in the matter of their admission in your institution during the academic session 2002-2003.

- (i) Extension in date of admission by about 30 days.
- (ii) Relaxation in cut off percentage upto 10% subject to minimum eligibility requirement.
- (iii) Increase in intake capacity up to 5% - course - wise.
- (iv) Retervation of at least one seat in merit quota in technical/professional institutions.
- (v) Waving of domicile requirements.
- (iv) Facilitation of migration in second and subsequent years.

3. You are kindly requested to ensure the same.
