

- (i) Temporary/adhoc service of Shri. Moses Mao,
Lecturer in Library & Information Science

Shri. Moses Mao Naga was appointed temporary Lecturer w.e.f. 29.9.91 for a period of six months in the scale of Rs.2200-4000/- against the leave vacancy E.O.L., period availed by Dr. A.S. Chandel, Reader of Library and Information Science. The temporary appointment was further extended from time to time, continuously without break upto 26.7.96 for a period of 5 years and was allowed periodical increments, raising his basic to Rs.2575/-. Subsequently, he was appointed on regular basis w.e.f. 27.7.96 on the recommendation of the Selection Committee and approval of the Executive Committee. He then requested for fixing pay protecting his last pay drawn on temporary basis. The matter was examined but in view of the observation of the then Audit officer, that past service as a VF/ Lecturer on contract will not count for any purpose within the meaning of FR/ordinances, his request was regretted and pay was fixed at the minimum @ Rs.2200/- of the Lecturer scale in his regular appointment.

Shri. M.M. Naga has again represented for protection of his pay on temporary basis. Considering that his service was extended without any break and was also given 5 increments, the matter was re-examined and the Audit officer has stated that "FR-26 is very clear which stipulates that all periods of duty in a post on a time scale counts for increments in that time scale". Since the concerned teacher has been performing duties continuously since 29.9.91 and was allowed periodical increments to make the stage of Rs.2575/- his pay on his regular appointment should be protected. However his seniority will be determined from the date of his regular appointment w.e.f. 26.7.96.

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration.

- (iv) Curtailment of study leave in respect of Dr. Topash Chakraborty, Scientific Officer, RSIC before the expiry of the sanctioned study leave.

- (i) Temporary / ad-hoc service of Shri Moses Mao, Lecturer in Library and Information Science.

- (iii) Placement in the Senior Scale of Shri K. Nengnong, Assistant Registrar.

- (iv) Revision of Pay Scale in respect of Principal, Pachhunga University College.

EC:100:99:6:6: (iv): The Council considered the fixation of salary in respect of the Principal, Pachhunga University College and RESOLVED that the present incumbent may be placed in the scale of Rs.16,400-450-20,900-500-22,400- minimum to be fixed at Rs. 17,300/- as purely personal to him. In future, the post of the College Principal may be advertised in the Reader's scale as the College is an Under-Graduate College.
