

- (i) Deputation term in respect of Prof. J.B. Bhattacharjee, Deptt. of History & extension thereto.

The Executive Council vide resolution No:EC:82:94: 03:(ii) held on 29.3.94, approved the release of Prof. J.B. Bhattacharjee w.e.f 21.1.94 on deputation terms for a period of five yrs to take up an assignment as Vice-Chancellor Assam University, Silchar. The term of his deputation expired on 20.1.99 and Prof. J.B. Bhattacharjee vide FAX Message dated 18.1.99 (Annexure-I) informed that the Hon'ble Visitor may require some time to appoint the next Vice-Chancellor Assam University. In this context, Prof. J.B. In view of above, the extension deputation term of Prof. J.B. Bhattacharjee w.e.f 21.1.99 as Vice-Chancellor Assam University is placed before the Council for consideration.

Sir,

I was granted leave on deputation basis w.e.f 21 January 1994 for a period of five years to enable me to assume charge as First Vice-Chancellor of Assam University, Silchar, vide letter No.17-24/Estt.II/82-6177 dated January 1994. Accordingly my leave on deputation will expire on 20 January 1999. I shall also complete my term as First Vice-Chancellor of Assam University on that date. I am now ready to rejoin my substantive post as Professor of History in NEHU.

It appears that the Hon'ble Visitor may require some time to appoint the next Vice-Chancellor, Assam University. On my part, I had brought this to the notice of the Govt at least six months earlier, and the Executive Council of the University completed its formality. As far as I could gather, the matter is now under process, and the next Vice-Chancellor is likely to be appointed shortly. It may take a few days, or weeks or months. In this context, Statute 2 of Assam University Act 1989 states as follows, "Provided that notwithstanding the expiry of the said period of five years, he(Vice-Chancellor) shall continue in office until his successor is appointed and enters upon his office". I have been told that a formal communication from the Government to this effect is also expected shortly.

Therefore, I request you to kindly extend my leave on deputation basis from NEHU till such date that I am relieved of my office as Vice-Chancellor of Assam University, Silchar.
