

It(MI) ... Grant of lien to Dr. V.K. Kumar, Professor,
Department of Commerce.

Dr. V. K. Kumar, Professor and Head, Deptt. of Commerce has applied for a post of Professorship at the Indian Institute of Management, Calicut and his application was duly forwarded by NSHU dt. 28.5.97.

Prof. Kumar submitted an application dt. 12.8.97 to the Vice-Chancellor that he has been selected to the post of Professor in the scale of Rs.5100 - 7300/- and that he has accepted the offer and thus requested to grant him lien for 2 (Two) years and to relieve him at the earliest. The Dean, School of Economic, Management and Information Sciences, forwarded the application and strongly recommended that Prof. Kumar may be released at the earliest possible with an assurance that all the arrangement of teaching in the Department, have been made.

Prof. V.K. Kumar is a confirmed employee and served the University continuously for a period of 12 (twelve) years 9 (Nine) months w.e.f. 22.10.84. As per G.O.I. rule, lien can be retained by a permanent/confirmed Government employee for a period of two years provided the application for the post is forwarded through proper channel. Thus Prof. Kumar fulfills the condition to retain lien in the post on his appoint at Indian Institute of Management, Calicut.

The No Dues Certificates obtained from the concerned sections, states that he has got some outstanding dues against car advance amounting to Rs.75,527/- including interest. Prof. Kumar has submitted an undertaking to remit every month the Car-Loan Instalment along with G.P.F. contribution and LIC (Group). In case
