

(v) Foreign Contributions for the period spent on Extraordinary Leave by Dr. B. Pakem, Vice-Chancellor.

The Executive Council held on 24.3.98 vide its resolution No:EC:96:98:6:3:(ii) has resolved that the leave salary and pension contribution for the period spent on Extraordinary Leave is to be paid to the University either by Prof. B. Pakem to the foreign employer for pensionary benefits.

However, on further examination of the matter it is found that as per clause 8 (iii) (d) of the Ordinance OE-6, the period spent on Extra-ordinary Leave shall not count for pensionary/contributory provident fund benefits unless the pension/contributory provident fund contributions are paid by the teacher or the foreign employer for the period of Extra-ordinary Leave so spent. The question for payment of Leave Salary Contributions will, therefore, not arise. The amount payable either by the Government of Meghalaya or by Prof. B. Pakem is Rs.925.00 and Rs.1037.00 for the period from 10.3.78 to 9.3.79 and from 7.5.79 to 6.5.80 respectively.

The matter is placed before the Executive Council for review of the earlier decision taken under the resolution No:96:98:6:3:(ii).

## (iii) TA / DA Advance in respect of Dr. RS Tripathi.

EC:97:98:6:6:(iii): The Council considered the late submission of TA/DA final bill against an advance of Rs. 52,140/- drawn by Dr. RS Tripathi, Professor in Botany and RESOLVED that the delay be condoned on the condition that this is the first lapse in submitting a final bill by Dr. RS Tripathi, during his service with the University.

## (iv) Adoption of decision of the Govt. of India in respect of revision of Pension of Pre-1996 Pensioners/Family Pensioners etc. and the post 1996 Pensioners.

EC:97:98:6:6:(iv): The Council considered the revised rate of pension as notified in the Government of India's Gazette No. 192 of 30.9.1997 and RESOLVED to adopt the same.

## (v) Foreign Contributions for the period spent on EOL by Dr. B. Pakem, Vice - Chancellor.

EC:97:98:6:6:(v): The Council considered the payment of leave salary and pension contribution in respect of Dr. B. Pakem as RESOLVED in its 96<sup>th</sup> meeting and RESOLVED that in view of the provisions of the Ordinance only the pension contribution be paid either by the Govt. of Meghalaya or by Dr. B. Pakem.

## (vi) Pay revision of Employees of Central Universities etc. pursuant to the recommendation of the Vth Pay Commission.

EC:97:98:6:6:(vi): The Council considered the payment of revised pay to the following categories of existing employees and RESOLVED that provisional payment be made subject to the employees concerned giving an undertaking to refund the amount paid if the revised pay is not approved by the University Grants Commission.
