

6:6 Service condition/Financial and other Benefits

i) : Medical Reimbursement in respect of Prof. A.K.Baruah, department of Political Science.

Prof. A.K.Baruah was granted Medical Advance of Rs.24,000/- for his medical treatment in Down Town Hospital, Guwahati. An expenditure of Rs. 32,352/- was incurred for the said treatment.

The final bill was regulated in accordance with AMA Rules for adjustment against the said advance out of which Rs16,889/- was admitted being the cost of admissible items/medicines. An amount of Rs 15,462.78p could not be admitted due to the following inadmissible items and medicines as per AMA Rules.

Accordingly Prof. Baruah was advised to refund an amount of Rs. 7,111/- as against the advance drawn by him.

Prof. A.K.Baruah had requested that in consideration of nature of his ailment, it necessitated special nursing attendance which was very essential for his recovery and therefore the charges for nursing as stated against Sl no 3 for Rs 1,300/- may be considered for reimbursement by the University.

Further, under Sl.no 1 above, the total charges towards accomodation was Rs.10,500/- @ Rs. 450/- per day for 2 days and Rs 400/- per day for 24 days. However as per approved room rent, the University allows Rs 150/- per day. In this regard Prof.A.K. Baruah has requested that the Room rent be admitted as charged by Down Town Hospital, Guwahati considering the nature of ailment which required immediate hospitalisation on emergency basis for treatment of a ' Stroke '(Representation at annexure I.)

In the above content, it may be stated here that as per AMA(Rules) the charges for special nursing is admissible provided it is recommended and certified by the Hospital Authorities. No certification to this effect has been made by the Hospital Authorities. As regard the room rent, the University has been reimbursing room rent @ Rs.150/- per day at flat rate for all categories of the employees admitted in recognised Hospitals.

Under the given content the matter is placed before the Executive Council for a decision.

Further it may be stated that similar representations of cases may arise in future and therefore it would be necessary for the Council to arrive at a policy decision in the matter of relaxation.

Sir,

As you know last year I had to be hospitalized on an emergency basis for treatment of a stroke. It was a life and death question and no time could be lost looking for rates etc. Now the finance has told me that though I was hospitalized in Down Town because no other hospital with a reputed Neurologist was available immediately, the room rent will be paid according to local hospital rates only. The department also informs that the charge for nursing could not be reimbursed. In view of the nature of the ailment I request you to give special permission to reimburse the room rent at least at Christian Medical College rates which NEHU recognizes. I also request you to permit Nursing charges as the Hospital had certified that it was essential. It is obvious at a paralysed patient can not do without professional nursing.

I hope a favourable decision will be taken at an early date.
