(xiii) Deduction of HRA and Licence fee from the staff on Essential Duty.

The University has not been provided with Quarters to Non-Teaching employees as the construction of ^{Quarters for} Non-Teaching Staff is under the IXth Plan proposal and as soon as the plan proposal is approved and fund is released by the UGC, the construction work will be taken up (Letter at annexure I may please be seen).

However, there are some employees under the "Essential Duty" are allowed by the University to use the renovated sheds vacated by labourers of the companies including other University buildings. But it may be mentioned that the buildings are very old, no attached bathroom, and the toilet has to be shared among them and not as per their entitlement.

But the University has deducted the full amount of House Rent Allowance and 10% Licence fee from the above categories of employees who were allowed to use the said sheds/Buildings as per the rule of allotment of Quarters.

As mentioned in the Para-I above, the University has not been provided with Quarters to any Non-Teaching Staff but arrangement to stay for those staff on "Essential Duty" has been made by University to avoid disruption of duty and they will have to vacate the House if there are no longer on "Essential Duty" which is similar to the case of Railway Staff on duty from one place to other place ~~duty~~ provided with a house to stay as long as they are on duty without any deduction of HRA and licence fee.

In view of the above, the matter is therefore placed before the EC to consider the withdrawal of HRA ^{of licence fee} deducted from the above staff on "Essential duty" in absence of Govt. Quarters from the date as decided by the Council.
