Existing Provisions

Vice Chancellor's quota -10%  
To be nominated by the MHRD  
The level of literacy at the Block level, duly certified by the concerned Deputy Commissioner shall be taken as a guiding factor.

A candidate should have a minimum of 40% physical deformity which causes an interference with the normal functioning of bones, muscles and joints. Similar provisions will be made for the deaf, dumb etc.

Modifications/additions.

University's Special Quota-10%  
Proposed to be deleted

Educationally Backward areas.

The level of backwardness may be determined vis-a vis the national level of literacy. An applicant coming from an area having 5% below the national level of literacy may be given 5% added weightage to the marks obtained by the applicant in the qualifying exams. Applications with more than 5% below the national level of literacy may be given 7% added weightage to the marks obtained by the applicant at the qualifying exams.

Such applications will be Centrally examined by Medical Board. 3% of the seats may be reserved for the physically handicapped candidates which may be taken from the open category. This category may not come under the University special quota.

An applicant <sup>with</sup> 40% to 60% Physical disability may be given 5% added weightage and above 60%-7% added weightage.

10% for representing the country at International level, 5% for representing the State at National level and 3% for Inter University at National level added weightage to the marks obtained at the qualifying exams, sports

7% added weightage to the marks obtained at the qualifying exams. Certificate of employment may be issued by the office of Registrar.

6. Outstanding Sportsmen/women

The level of participation at the inter University/State or National level within the last 3 years shall be taken into account.

7. Children of NEHU employees or its employees.

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8. Children of employees with all India transfer liability, excluding private organisations.

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9. Donor non-resident Indian

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Note:

1. In case(s) of equal claim (s) (between the intra or inter categories) a written test/oral test, as may be decided by the concerned Deptt., may be held to determine their inter se merit.
2. Category under sl. 2, 7, & 8 stand deleted as the same are likely to create some administrative problems some day in the future.
3. Under this scheme, each Department will be required to prepare a consolidated list of all applicants under the quota and finalise the list of selected candidates based on the above principle.
4. Under the existing principles for such selection, the performance of such students at the qualifying examinations was not taken into account at all. However, under the proposed scheme, the same is proposed to be taken into account, in addition to the points of special consideration.

5. In the same logic that a candidate can apply for admission into more than once discipline, such candidates may also apply for other disciplines.
6. A candidate applying to be considered under this quota, shall be required to fill in only one application form for such, which will be considered under the open, reserved or University special quota. However, if such applicant is applying to more than one Deptt., shall be required to fill in separate application.
7. Other Procedural methods to be followed shall remain the same.

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## (ii) On the procedure for admission to the Ph.D. Programmes.

EC:99:98:5:1: (ii): The Council considered the procedure of admission to the Ph.D. Programmes and RESOLVED that the second sentence of Clause 1(1) of Ordinance OC-4 be amended as to read as "The candidates with at least 55% marks in their Master's Degree in the subject concerned / allied subject / cognate subject will be required to appear in a written test or interview to be conducted by the Department", and that all past cases which have not followed the correct procedure be regularised while the cases in process be required to follow the above.

## (iii) Regulation of Admission and fees structure in Private Non-aided Professional Institutions.

EC:99:98:5:1: (iii): The Council considered the regulation of admission and fee structure in Private Non-aided Institutions as recommended by the University Grants Commission and RESOLVED to accept the same.
