

EXAMINATION MATTERS

- (i) Permission to increase in the number of seats in M.Sc. Chemistry.

A request had been received from the Head, Department of Chemistry for permission to increase the present number of 29 (Twenty nine) seats in the Department to 30 (Thirty) numbers, due to the increase in the number of students seeking admission for the M.Sc. Programmes in Chemistry. In view of the urgency of the matter, temporary permission has been granted.

The matter was placed before the 58th meeting of the Academic Council held on 10th September, 1998 and the Council ratified the action taken in granting permission to the request of the Head, Department of Chemistry to increase in the number of seats in M.Sc. Chemistry from 29 to 30 numbers on account of the increase of the number of students and RESOLVED to approve the same.
