Existing provision	Proposed amendment/addition
ARTICLE V : <u>MEMBERSHIP</u>	
Clause 2 : Every member shall be required to pay an initial enrolment fee at Rs.2/- and every new member seeking enrolment shall apply to the General Secretary in the form prescribed at Scheduled I of this constitution.	Henceforth, there will be no enrolment fee for the existing employees and automatically they shall become the member of the Association on payment of subscription fee of Rs.5/- per month which will be enhanced from time to time on the approval of G.B. Enrolment.
ARTICLE VII: <u>REMOVAL OF MEMBERS:</u>	<u>SUSPENSION/REMPVAL OF MEMBERS</u>
Clause 1(1): A member may be removed from the membership of of the Association if he: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wilfully violates the provisions of the Constitution. (ii) refuses to comply with the directives of the Association. (iii) behave or acts in amanner prejudicial to the interest & fair name of the Association. (iv) is removed from the services of the University or College or Institution maintained by it. 	1(1) A member may be suspended/removed from the membership of the Association. If he/she <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wilfully violates the provisions of the Constitution. (ii) refuses to comply with the directives of the Association. (iii) behave or acts in a manner prejudicial to the interest and fair name of the Association. (iv) is removed from the services of the University or College or Institution maintained by it.
	Clause 1(ii): The Staff Council has the power to suspend any member violating the Clause 1(i) of Art.VII and also decide the period/duration of suspension as the case be.
ARTICLE VIII: <u>STAFF COUNCIL</u>	
Clause 3 : <u>Term of Office</u> : The tenure of the elected members shall be for one year from the date of the first meeting of the Staff Council.	The tenure of elected members shall be for 2 years from the date of the first sitting of the Staff Council, he shall be eligible for re-election for succeeding term.

ARTICLE XII: FINANCIAL YEAR

The Financial year of the Association shall commence from the 1st of January and end on the 31st of December.

: The financial year of the Association shall commence from the first June to 31st May.

SUSPENSION/REMOVAL OF MEMBERS

(i) A member may be suspended/removed from the membership of the Association if he/she (i) Willfully violates the provisions of the Constitution, (ii) refuses to comply with the directives of the Association, (iii) behaves or acts in a manner prejudicial to the interest of the Association, (iv) is removed from the services of the University or College or institution maintained by it.

ARTICLE VII: REMOVAL OF MEMBERS
Clause (i): A member may be removed from the membership of the Association if he/she (i) Willfully violates the provisions of the Constitution, (ii) refuses to comply with the directives of the Association, (iii) behaves or acts in a manner prejudicial to the interest of the Association, (iv) is removed from the services of the University or College or institution maintained by it.

Clause (ii): The Staff Council shall have the power to suspend any member violating the Clause (i) of Art. VII and also decide the period of suspension in the case of the case.

ARTICLE VIII: STAFF COUNCIL
Clause 3: Term of Office: The tenure of the elected members shall be for one year from the date of the first meeting of the Staff Council.

The tenure of elected members shall be for 2 years from the date of the first sitting of the Staff Council. He shall be eligible for re-election for succeeding term.
