(XII) from Nagaland.

Consequent upon the existence of Nagaland University w.e.f. 6.9.1994, the faculty members and Group 'A' non-teaching who have opted for NNU., were allowed to remain with the Nagaland University and treated as on deputation upto 31.12.95.

On the expiry of the above period, some of them have joined the Headquarters w.e.f. 2.1.1996 and some still remains with Nagaland University on deputation. The employees repatriated from Nagaland University were posted at Shillong, and Mizoram Campuses and Pachhunga University College. The three P.G. departments were established at the Headquarters and Mizoram Campus, namely, Commerce and Linguistics at Headquarters and Geology at Mizoram Campus approved by the Executive Council at its 84th meeting held on 8.12.94 and 89th meeting held on 8.3.96. Some of the teachers of Nagaland University who had earlier opted for NNU had now requested that they may be absorbed in Nagaland University, for which the office has issued a no objection certificate to the Nagaland University. The list of teachers and Group 'A' officers repatriated to NNU and places of posting is placed at Annexure 'A'.

Further, a D.O. letter No.F.7-1/90(CU) dated 29.10.96, received from the Chairperson UGC regarding starting of the Department of Commerce, Linguistics and Geology stating that due to financial constraints, we may need to find new Departments only in the IX Plan. In the meantime, these faculty members be adjusted in the allied Departments. The D.O. letter is placed at Annexure 'B'.

In view of the UGC's letter above, all those employees/staff returned from Nagaland University have been posted accordingly and the posts are treated as personal to them. However, it may be mentioned here that one post of Reader and Lecturer in the History Department are vacant and for which the matter will be taken up with the Head of the Department of History if they can be accommodated against the sanctioned posts.

The matter is reported to the Council for the creation of the post of the teacher/officers as per the Annexure 'A' which will be personal to be incumbents concerned.

Please refer to your D.O. letter No.PL.4-1/Grant/95-2188 dated 23rd August, 1996, enclosing therewith a copy of your letter No.PL.4-1/Grant.95-2187 dated 23rd August, 1996 addressed to the Ministry of Human Resource Development, regarding starting of Department of Commerce, Linguistics and Geology. Due to financial constraints, we may need to find new departments only in the IXth Plan. In the meantime, could these faculty members be adjusted in allied departments? With respect to the creation of posts, specifically for non-teaching staff have opted for NNU services already joined from the Nagaland Campuses, the services of these employees may be utilised wherever required and no new non-teaching post may be created till all these employees are absorbed against regular posts. This would also apply to the proposed Department of Hindi. Please see the last paragraph of this letter.

The issue relating to the creation of posts for the staff repatriated from Nagaland Campuses, the post(s) may be created in your University "as personal" to them only if there is no existing vacancy. For posts which are personal to them, the said post would stand abolished, as and when they retire or leave the services of your University.

FEES : (1) For appearance in cases before the Principal Seat at Guwahati (Civil/Criminal/Writ Petition/ Appeals) lumpsum amount of Rs.10,000/-or Rs.15,000/- per case, depending on the nature of each case, till the case is finally disposed of.

(2) For drafting and settling of counter affidavits/ additional affidavits/ miscellaneous petitions etc. Rs.3000/-

(3) For conducting cases before the Shillong Bench Rs.9000/- per day/ appearance.
