

(iii) Closure of the ISOS and Bio-Physics

The Executive Council in its 96th meeting considered the closure of the Institute of Self-Organising Systems and Bio-Physics and Resolved that the Institute should not take further admission of Students into the M.Phil/Ph.D Programme. Further, the Council decided that the matter be placed before the Academic Council.

The matter was placed before the 57th meeting of the Academic Council and the Council considered the decision of the Executive Council not to allow further admission of students into M.Phil/Ph.D Programmes of the ISOS and BP and Resolved that the teachers of the Institute may register M.Phil/Ph.D candidates through other Departments.

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration.
