

- (ii) Cooling off period between two deputation/lien terms in respect of Dr.V.B.Singh, Reader, Department of Horticulture, NEHU.

Dr.V.B. Singh joined as Lecturer in SASRD, Medziphema with effect from 31.8.81. He was, later, appointed to the post of Reader in the same Department from 12.5.88.

With the coming up of the Nagaland University, Dr.V.B. Sing had opted for NEHU service.

During his service as Reader in NEHU, he was granted lien for 3 years with effect from 25.11.93 for taking up an appointment as Chief Training Officer with the Deendayal Research Institute, Chitrakoot, Madhya Pradesh. However, before expiry of his lien, he returned to Shillong on 1.7.96.

Subsequently, Dr.V.B. Singh was selected for the post of Professor in Nagaland University and a lien was again granted to him for a period of 2 years w.e.f. 5.7.96. Later, his lien was extended for another period of 1 year w.e.f. 5.7.98 to 4.7.99.

Now, while in Nagaland University on lien, the Vice-Chancellor of Nagaland University sent an application of Dr.V.B. Sing for onward transmission to the Vice-Chancellor, Central Agricultural University, Imphal, Manipur applying for the post of Dean/OSD at College of Horticulture and Forestry, Arunachal Pradesh under Central Agricultural University, Imphal. Presumably, if this application of Dr. Singh is farwarded and in the event of his selection, the University is liable to grant him lien to the post.

Apart from this case, there are other cases also where teachers have been going on lien frequently from one spell to another and the existing rules are silent in regard to that the teachers on lien should at least serve the parent Department for a certain period.

It is felt necessary that a decision regarding the cooling off period is to be taken in order to avoid teachers/Officers from going on lien frequently from one spell to another.

The matter, is, therefore, placed to the Council for its consideration and decision.

- (ii) Cooling off period between two deputation lien terms in respect of of Dr. VB Singh, Reader, Deptt. of Horticulture, NEHU.

EC:99:98:6:3: (ii): The Council considered the request of Dr. VB Singh to forward his application to the Central Agricultural University, Imphal, Manipur, while still on deputation to Nagaland University and RESOLVED to regret the same as his lien period will be shortly expiring on 4.7.99. With regards to cooling off period between two leaves the Council further RESOLVED that for leaves other than those specified in Ordinances by separate provisions and statutory appointments, the cooling off period between two leaves be one year for leave beyond one year and for leave below one year be it decided on the merit of each case.

- (iii) Extension of deputation in respect of Shri Atul Dev Sarmah, Assistant Editor, NEHU, Shillong.

EC:99:98:6:3: (iii): The Council considered the extension of deputation in respect of Shri Atul Dev Sarmah and RESOLVED that since the period of deputation has exceeded five years he may be asked to resume duties at NEHU by 15.1.99 failing which the post held by him will be deemed to have been vacated w.e.f. the date he proceeded on deputation.

- (iv) Earned Leave in respect of Dr. Vinod Singh, ISOSB, NEHU, Shillong.

EC:99:98:6:3: (iv): The Council considered the grant of Earned leave to Dr. Vinod Singh and RESOLVED to authorise the Chairman to see if he has been permitted. If he has proceeded on leave without permission the Chairman may take appropriate action.
