

(ii) Status Report on NERIST.

The Academic Council vide Resolution No.AC:57:98:5:8:(xiii) had deferred the consideration of recognition of the teachers of NERIST as Ph.D. Supervisors and resolved that the office may place a note on the status of NERIST.

Affiliation of NERIST was first considered by the Academic Council on the request of the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India, on the 3rd March, 1990. Subsequently, the Academic Council in its 40th meeting held on 1st November, 1990 resolved to ratify the grant of Affiliation to NERIST. The Academic Council in its 51st meeting held on 2nd and 3rd November, 1995 resolved to recognise NERIST as a Research Institute and also to recognise some of its teachers in the Department of Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Forestry as Supervisors for Ph.D. Programmes.

The matter was placed before the Academic Council in its 58th meeting held on 10.9.98 and the Council resolved that the decision of the Academic Council taken in its 51st meeting may read as " to recognise some of its (NERIST) teachers in the Departments of Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Forestry as co-Supervisors for Ph.D. Programmes". The Council further resolved that the recognition of the Co-Supervisors should first be placed before the respective School Boards for recommendation. The Course and Syllabi of the Institute should also be placed before the Academic Council for approval.

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration.

(ii) Status Report on NERIST.
