The Chairman welcomed the members and requested Prof.S.N.Bhat to initiate the discussion. Prof.Bhat read out the letter dated 26.4.96. The members then decided that the term of reference of the sub-committee is to consider the admissibility of advance increment(s) for the Scientific Officers who had Ph.D, degree or M.Phil and at the time of joining the service in RSIC. Accordingly the Committee decided to restrict its recommendation to the term of references.

The Committee then considered the objective of RSIC as stated in the Memo of Understanding signed between the University and the Department of Science & Technology, New-Delhi. The Committee also considered the recommendation made by the CMC, RSIC, vide its meeting held on 14.5.1986.

After a thread bare discussion on the issue, the Sub-Committee unanimously made the following recommendation to the Executive Council for consideration.

The Scientific Officers of the RSIC having Ph.D or M.Phil degree at the time of joining the post of Scientific Officer may be considered three/one advance increment respectively with the prior approval of the D.S.T, the funding agency.
