

5: 7: - AFFILIATION ETC.

- (i) Inspection reports of various Colleges for Permanent/Renewal/Initial affiliation.

The 59th meeting of the Academic Council held on 19th & 20th November, 1998 considered the Recommendations of the various Inspection Teams for affiliation of the following Colleges and RESOLVED as indicated against each in addition to appointments of teachers as per University Grants Commission norms.

Name of College	Recommendations
1. Don Bosco College	Provisional Affiliation for Honours in Philosophy and Garo subject to full-fulfilment of the conditions laid down by the Inspection Team.
2. Durama College	Extension of Provisional affiliation for a period of three years subject to fulfilment of the conditions laid down by the Inspection Team.
3. Comprehensive School and Degree College, Venghlui, Aizawl.	Provisional affiliation be granted for a period of two years subject to the fulfilment of the conditions laid down by the Inspection Team.
4. Shillong Law College	While approving the affiliation as proposed, the Council expressed concern at the proposal of the B. C I., connoting interference in the autonomy and jurisdiction of the University, given to it by an Act of the Parliament. This may be conveyed to the B C I.
5. Acheng Rangmanpa College.	Renewal of Provisional affiliation for a period of three years w.e.f. 1996. The College is to be reprimanded for non-fulfilment of the terms required for renewal of provisional affiliation and the Director, CDC is to maintain a watch on all such cases.

6. Aizawl West College Renewal of Provisional affiliation for a period of three w.e.f. 1996 and action be taken as in the case of Acheng Rangmanpa College.

7. BBS College, Shillong. Renewal of Provisional affiliation for a period of three years subject to the College appointing NET Qualified teachers.

8. NERIST Provisional affiliation for M.Tech Course is regretted by the Council and the Council takes a serious view of the Institute enrolling M.Tech students without authorisation from NEHU and a time bar be fixed for the Institute to reply to the COE's letter. The Council, further RESOLVED to draw the attention of the Executive Council ^{to the right of the University to with} the privileges granted to the Institute, as the Institute has shown gross neglect in consulting NEHU about its academic Programmes.

9. College of Teachers' Education. Permanent affiliation of the College was deferred as the Committee on Permanent affiliation is yet to submit its report.

10. Tiro Singh Memorial College. Permanent affiliation of the College was deferred as the Committee on Permanent affiliation is yet to submit its report.

The matter is placed before the Council for Consideration.

(ii) Starting of the Department of M. C. A.

EC:99:98:5:6: (ii): The Council considered the placement of the Department of MCA and while noting the representations received from the Departments of the School of Physical Sciences RESOLVED to approve the decision of the Academic Council to place the Department of Computer Applications under the School of Economics Management & Information Sciences. The Council also noted the dissent to its decision from Prof. AL Verma. (Annexure -D).

5:7- AFFILIATION ETC.

(i) Inspection Reports of various Colleges for Permanent / Renewal / Initial affiliation.

EC:99:98:5:7: (i): The Council considered the recommendations of the Academic Council on the permanent / renewal / initial affiliation of the following Colleges and while approving the affiliations subject to fulfilment of the conditions laid down by the Inspection Teams RESOLVED that all the Colleges under the jurisdiction of the University be required to make appointments of their teachers as per the UGC norms including NET examinations.

As regards NERIST a Show Cause Notice be issued as to why the privileges of NEHU should not be withdrawn on the following grounds:

- (a) Collecting fees in the name of NEHU without obtaining any prior authority or permission from the University.
- (b) Using the seal and designation of the Vice - Chancellor of NEHU in the fee receipts without any authority or permission from the University.

The Chairman is authorised to take necessary action on the reply from NERIST which should be submitted latest by 10.1.1999.
