

- (ii) Payment of monthly remuneration to Dr. E.D. Thomas for holding additional charge as Teacher incharge, Sports Department -

Prof. R. Gopalakrishnan who was earlier appointed as Professor in-charge (Sports) has been appointed as Controller of Examinations.

The V.C. has, therefore, appointed Dr E.D. Thomas, Reader, Department of Economics as teacher incharge (Sports) with effect from the date of taking over charge vide notification No.F.9-5/Estt-II/85-371 dated 3.7.97 and action since ratified by the 93rd E.C. vide resolution No. 93:97:3:(xi).

Dr E.D. Thomas vide letter dated 22.8.97 has requested for payment of monthly remuneration of Rs.500/- p.m. for holding the additional charge, which had been paid to all previous teachers i/c. Sports in addition to their normal duties.
