

(ii) LTC CLAIM IN RESPECT OF SHRI K. TARIANG S.O IN CDD.

Shri Khambor Tariang Section Officer in his letter dated 3/11/90 has requested the University Authority to consider condonation of late submission of his Final LTC bill as he could not submit the bills in time because the vouchers were misplaced by him at the time of shifting to the newly constructed house, It took him much time to locate the same and hence the delay in submission.

It may be stated that as per C.C.S (LTC) Rules 15 (VI) it is mentioned that where an advance has been drawn by the Govt. servant the claim for re-imbusement of expenditure incurred on the journey shall be submitted within one month of the completion of the return journey. On the Govt. servant's failure to do so he shall be required to refund the entire amount of advance forthwith in one lumpsum. No request for recovery of an advance in instalments shall be entertained. As for the power to relax such claims, the rule 18 says, "Save as otherwise provided in these rules, where any Ministry or Deptt. of the Govt. is satisfied that the operation of any of these rules causes un-due hardship to any particular case that Ministry or Department as the case may be, may by order for reasons to be recorded in writing dispense with or relax the requirement of that rule to such an extent and subjected to such exception and conditions and it may be considered necessary for dealing with the case in a just and equitable manner provided that no such order shall be made except with the concurrence of the Deptt. of Personal and Training."

Further EC Resolution No:91:96:6:6:(Viii) resolved "that the condonation will be given only once to an employee during his/her service career at NEHU and the Finance Deptt., will maintain a Register of employees who have availed of this condonation. the same would apply to LTC claims also."

In this connection it may be informed that Shri Khambor Tariang is a first time defaulter in this regard.

In view of the above circumstances mentioned above the matter is placed before the EC for consideration and necessary action.

- (ii) LTC Claim in respect of Shri K. Tariang, Section Officer, CDD.

EC:100:99:6:6: (ii): The Council considered the late submission of the final LTC bill in respect of Shri K. Tariang, Section Officer, CDD, and RESOLVED to condone the same as he is the first time defaulter.

- (iii) Placement in the Senior Scale of Shri K. Nengnong, Assistant Registrar.

EC:100:99:6:6: (iii): The Council considered the placement in the Senior Scale in respect of Shri K. Nengnong and RESOLVED that the shortage of days of training may be met by another training period and the matter be placed before the DPC before consideration by the Council.

- (iv) Revision of Pay Scale in respect of Principal, Pachhunga University College.

EC:100:99:6:6: (iv): The Council considered the fixation of salary in respect of the Principal, Pachhunga University College and RESOLVED that the present incumbent may be placed in the scale of Rs.16,400-450-20,900-500-22,400- minimum to be fixed at Rs. 17,300/- as purely personal to him. In future, the post of the College Principal may be advertised in the Reader's scale as the College is an Under-Graduate College.
