




(ii) Confirmation of Minutes of the 4th Emergent Meeting of the Academic Council held on 19th August, 2010.

ITEM NO.2 REPORTING ITEM

(i) Proposed revolving Annual Fund for the Centre of Distance Education, NEHU.

The Council noted that the income generated over a period of 3 years amounted to Rs.21.43 lacs of which an amount of Rs.7 lacs per year was deposited in NEHU Account. The Council also observed that for running the Programmes offered by the Centre for Distance Education, cost analysis be reviewed for the purpose of cost effectiveness and with regard to admission of students the minimum number should not be less than 10 (ten).

(ii) Ordinance OC-19 on Distance Mode of Education as per MHRD direction.
