

(X) Case of Shri.L.K.Rathore, Work-charged Junior Engineer
in the matter of :

(a) Settlement of annual increments.

(b) Consideration of regularisation of service.

An agenda item was placed before the Executive Council in its last meeting held on 24.3.98 regarding the case of Shri.L.K.Rathore in the matter of (a) settlement of annual increments and (b) consideration of regularisation of service. The Council, vide its resolution No.EC:96:98:6:6:(xi) referred the case to the Advisory Committee on Cadre Management to check all the available records including the original Performance Reports. The Council also authorised the V.C. to take a decision on the matter on the basis of the Committee's Report.

In pursuance of the aforesaid resolution of the Executive Council, the Advisory Committee met on 10.7.98 but on going through the merit of the case, the Advisory Committee found that the case does not come within the purview of the Committee. The Committee however, recommends that if the case cannot be decided through the regular administrative channels the case may be referred to special administrative Committee that may be constituted for the purpose. Herein it may be pointed out that vide resolution No.EC:92:97:6:6:(vii) read with resolution No.EC:93:97:6:6:(xv), the terms of reference entrusted by the Council to the Advisory Committee are cases concerning upgradation and fitment.
