- (i) Guidelines for allowing Non-teaching staff for pursuing part time Ph.D degree.

Time and again requests are being received from Non-Teaching staff of the University to allow them for pursuing part time Ph.D. degree. In absence of codified guidelines, administration is facing problem to deal with such cases. However, in few cases no objections have been issued.

In view of the above, the matter is placed before the Council to provide guidelines in order to deal with such cases.

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The Executive Council also **RESOLVED** that the University should put pressure on the colleges for improvement. Inspection Teams shall visit the Colleges to verify whether the conditions laid down are fulfilled or not. The Executive Council further **RESOLVED** that the Director, CDC, may send a Circular to all colleges informing them that they should apply for affiliation as per the format at least **three** months before the expiry of the affiliation period and pay the prescribed fees. The Council felt the need that Press Release be issued to publicise the expiry of the affiliation period of Colleges to NEHU in the interest of the public.

Whenever there is recommendation for affiliation for one or two years only the college should apply for renewal along with necessary fees. The Inspection should be able to see progressive improvement of the college before making recommendation for affiliation.
