(iv) Screening of applications for Teaching Posts.

Regulation 13 of OE-3 clause(1) on the procedure for scrutiny of applications received for teaching posts is reproduced hereunder:-

The application of all candidates for the posts of Lecturer, Reader, Professor or equivalent will be forwarded by the University office to the Heads of the Departments concerned. However, if the Head of the Department happens to be a Reader, the applications for the posts of Professor or equivalent will be forwarded to Professor in the Department failing which to the Dean of School. The Head of Department shall constitute a Committee of not less than three members of the staff in the Department not below the rank of a Reader including the Professor(s) in the Department to scrutinise the applications for the Posts of Lecturers, Readers and **equivalent and for preparing a list of candidates for interview.** Similarly, a committee will be constituted by the Head of the Department or the Dean of the School, as the case may be for scrutinising the applications for the posts of Professor or equivalent. This Committee will comprise not less than three persons and shall include all Professors in the Department and at least one Professor from another Department in the School or other Schools.

With regards to the above, it may be mentioned herein that there are some teachers who has superannuated but was re-employed in the Departments concerned on contract basis. Since in the Ordinance, it is silent whether superannuated teachers can be a member of any Screening Committee of the Department, it is difficult for the office to decide whether a re-employed teachers can be a member of such screening Committee or not.

The matter was placed before the Academic Council meeting held on 21st and 22nd November, 1996 and the Council RESOLVED that since such teachers cannot hold an Administrative position as per Ordinance they cannot be allowed to take part in any screening procedure.

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration.

- (ii) Amendment to the Ordinance OA-2 and OA-4 to include the Department of Mizo under the School of Humanities and Education.
