

- (ix) - Recognition of Christian Hospital, Tura for medical treatment of NEHU Employees and family members stationed at Tura.

NEHU Campus Tura has already started functioning and the employees posted at Tura have joined. The University has not appointed any Medical Officer for the new campus and it is necessary to provide them with the facilities of medical treatment. It is, therefore, essential to recognise at least one hospital which is available near by. The Christian Hospital is located near the Tura Campus and the Hospital Authorities, on the approached made by the Officer-on-Special Duty, NEHU, Tura, have agreed to extend the medical care to the University staff and their family members stationed at Tura.

It is proposed to recognise Christian Hospital, Tura by the University.

It is, therefore, placed before the E.C. for consideration and approval.

(viii) Grant of One-upward movement beyond 31.12.93.

No:EC:90:96:6:6:(viii): The Council considered the grant of One-upward movement to the Group 'B' 'C' and 'D' staff beyond 31.12.93 and expressed its concern that the University Grants Commission had turned down the request of North-Eastern Hill University whereas other Central Universities like Aligarh Muslim University, University of Delhi and Jawaharlal Nehru University have been extended the grant of the one-upward movement till date, the Council further RESOLVED that the matter should be taken up afresh with the University Grants Commission.
