5: 1-Statutes/Ordinances, Regulation & Rules-

- (i) Amendment of Ordinance OE-3  
Clause 9 and 11

The E.C. Vide resolution No. EC: 89: 96: 6: 7(iii) adopted in its meeting held on 8th March, 1996 resolved that in future appointments made from the panel constituted by the Selection Committee should be limited to the number of vacancies that have been advertised.

As a result of the above resolution, Clause 9 and 11 of Ordinance OE-3 requires to be amended as under :-

<p>Clause 9 If more candidates than <del>the number of</del> vacancies are selected, the Selection Committee shall prepare a panel containing names of candidates in order of preference. The extra candidates found suitable shall constitute the reserve list. The reserve list shall remain confidential till an occasion arises for its use due to some selected candidates declining the offer or a new vacancy in the <del>same</del> specialisation/category becoming available.</p>	<p>If more candidates than the number of vacancies are selected, the Selection Committee shall prepare a panel containing names of candidates in order of preference. The extra-candidates found suitable shall constitute the reserve list. The reserve list shall remain confidential till an occasion arises for its use due to some selected candidates declining the offer only and shall not be used for appointments against posts other than that, that has been advertised..</p>
<p>Clause 11 The panel drawn up by the Selection Committee shall remain valid for a maximum period of one year.</p>	<p>The panel drawn up by the Selection Committee shall remain valid till the vacancies advertised are filled or till the panel is exhausted, whichever is earlier. Provided that the validity as such shall not exceed one year.</p>
