No: AC: 52: 96: 5: 5: (i): The Academic Council perused and deliberated upon the representation of Ms.L.V.Zodinpuii and also the judgement and Order of the Gauhati High Court, Aizawl Bench, regarding the case of Ms.L.V.Zodinpuii, who on not being allowed to submit her dissertation beyond the prescribed six semesters as per the communication made to her under letter No.EX/IG/Repeat/92-93-674 dated 21.7.1994, filed a Writ petition before the Gauhati High Court, Aizawl Bench under Civil Rule No.65/94.

The Council, as directed by the Court, deliberated upon the petition of Ms.Zodinpuii with special attention to para 6 and 7 of her Writ Petition. The Council, however, while sympathising with Ms.Zodinpuii, regretted its inability to allow extension of time to her for submission of her M.A dissertation in view of the provisions of the Ordinance which do not permit extension of time beyond six semesters as stated explicitly in Clause 15 of Ordinance OC-7

The Council in general stressed on compliance to the provisions of the Ordinance and RESOLVED that a Committee consisting of the following members may look into the irregularities that occurred in the Department of Education.
