The concept of participatory management and corporate responsibility has been well recognised and widely accepted in Central Universities. Therefore Delhi University and IGNOU has given proportionate representation to elected representatives of teachers in all Statutory Bodies and Committees of the Universities. Before Statutory changes could be initiated, the process to provide representation to the elected teachers has been implemented by changing procedure of nomination as such.

Very recently Education Secretary, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, took a meeting with UGC and FEDCUTA. In which it has been agreed upon to provide uniformity in Statutes of Central Universities containing provisions for elected representatives of teachers on all Statutory bodies and Committees. Welcoming the point initiation of the process has begun in this regard already.

In view of the above the Executive Committee of NEHUTA had decided to approach the Executive Council through you for an urgent consideration for providing proportionate representation to elected teachers in all Statutory Bodies and Committees so as to initiate a very healthy process of participatory management and corporate responsibility. That is why your good Offices were approached earlier on 11th July with a similar request (Copy enclosed). This would automatically improve transparency and accountability

Kindly place this item before the Executive Council for favourable considerations and expeditious perusals.

Till formally, through Statutes, the provisions are made, the consideration to provide representation as invitees may be kindly considered.

sity. It is our confidence that such participatory management and
shared responsibility will contribute much to the efficiency
and qualitative administration of the University System. There-
fore we write this letter to request you to kindly initiate the
process to provide proportionate representation to the elected
representatives of the university in all its statutory bodies
and important committees.

We may further submit that such provisions already exist in a
number of other Central Universities especially Indira Gandhi
National Open University and Delhi University. There is a pro-
vision for three elected representatives of teachers in the
Executive Council of DELHI UNIVERSITY also.

In our own university too, there is a provision for elected
representatives of staff in the court, and of college teachers
in the Academic Council. Similarly we hope that there should be
no difficulty to provide well justified proportionate represen-
tation to elected representatives of the teachers in all statu-
tory bodies and committees, constituted for the academic and
administrative functioning of the university

We shall be extremely grateful to you for your favourable
consideration and necessary action in this regard. You may kindly
consider to invite the elected representatives to all such
bodies till the required statutory amendments are made.
