

S. D. (iv) Subject:- PREMATURE RETIREMENT OF MRS B J NICOL,
SECTION OFFICER, NEHU, SHILLONG - REPORT OF THE
 COMMITTEE.

In pursuance of the E.C Resolution No. EC:90:96; 8:(iv) met on 19-9-96 and 23-09-96 on premature retirement of Mrs B J Nicol, a committee consisting of Prof R R Mishra Chairman, Prof A C Sinha member, and Prof B N Ehat, member was formed to look into the matter regarding the representation of Smt B J Nicol for review of the premature retirement order issued in her respect.

In this connection the report of the committee (at Annexure-I) recommends the following

- It was found:-
- (a) that Mrs Nicol claims that she was once offered the post of Assistant Registrar at SASRD, Medziphema and she could not join because of her domestic compulsions.
 - (b) After examining the relevant documents the committee found that in fact the University has issued a general circular to the Section Officer having more than 5(five) years experience to volunteer for the said job. Among the listed candidates Mrs Nicol ranked eleven. Thus her claim that once she was offered the said post has no validity.
 - (c) The other points mentioned in her representation had already been considered by the University before taking the decision of her premature retirement. Thus there is no new ground to re-open them in light of her representation.
 - (d) Furthermore, the committee examined the relevant documents pertaining to Mrs Nicol's premature retirement such as A.C.Rs for 5(five) years from 1991 to 1995, opinion of the Legal Adviser and the provisions of Rule 56(j) of the Fundamental Rules and found that the action taken by the university is appropriate.

Hence the matter is placed before the Council for consideration and decision.
