( iii) Deployment of Home Guards in the University Campus -

With the present law and order situation prevailing in the city of Shillong and its suburbs it is felt that the University Chowkidars are perhaps not adequate to deal with unforeseen circumstances. To augment the security in the Campus, it is felt that we should have some well trained security personnel. The State Police Department have been approached and though they have assured that periodical patrolling around , as well as within the Campus, will be carried out it would perhaps not meet the requirements of the University. It is, therefore , proposed that the University should engage a section of armed home guards to meet the purpose. The cost of engaging a section of armed home guards would run to approximately Rs.8 lakhs p.a and in addition they would also require accommodation for which one of the staff quarters near the VC's bungalow can be allotted to them.

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration.
