Hindi Cell was established in the University in pursuance of the Official Language Policy of the Government of India and to promote the progressive use of Hindi.

The supervision of proper implementation of Rajbhasha Policy is done by an Official Language Implementation Committee of the University. The Vice-Chancellor is the Chairman and In-Charge, Hindi Cell is the Member-Secretary of the Committee. The Registrar, Finance Officer, Controller of Examination, Librarian, Head, Hindi Department and all Deputy Registrars have been designated as members of the Committee. Apart from these, two Members of the Shillong Town Official Language Implementation Committee have also been included as the members of the Committee. Till date this Committee has convened 34 meetings and last meeting of the year under report was held on the 14th March, 2008.

Presently Hindi Cell is engaged with preparation of "Garo-Hindi-English" Dictionary.

1. Hindi Workshops at Shillong and Tura Campus were conducted for the employees having working knowledge of Hindi and to remove the hesitation to work in Hindi on files.
