Selection of Rajiv Gandhi Professor.

The 90th Executive Council held on 18-7-96 vide its resolution No.EC:90:96:8(v) has resolved that the earlier recommendation of Rajiv Gandhi Professor is not in consonance with the Ordinance framed for the above Chair by not recommending a panel of three names and the Council resolved that the Chairman of the Search Committee be informed accordingly. This resolution had been followed up by the Section as per Letter No.G.45-71/ACAD/AG Chair/94 dated 1-10-96 (Annexure A).

Subsequently, the Chairman Search Committee had preferred a petition asking for time to commence the meeting of the Search Committee for the above Chair. His Letter was placed to the 91st Executive Council held on 7-12-96. Accordingly, the Council has resolved to allow the time asked for by the Chairman and he, be informed accordingly vide Resolution No.EC:91:96:8:(i).

Finally, the Chairman of the Search Committee for the said Chair met on 10-1-97 at New Delhi. The Minutes of the meeting in Sealed cover have been received alongwith the bio-datas packet on 9-3-97 from him. These papers will be tabled by the Chair for perusal by the Council and decision on the above Chair.

The Chairman Search Committee for Rajiv Gandhi Chair has submitted the recommendation which was placed to the 90th Executive Council, NEHU held on 18-7-96.

The Council after having perused the same has resolved as under :- No.EC:90:96:8(v).

"The Chairman handed over the chair to the Pro-Vice-Chancellor, Mizoram Campus, to discuss the recommendation of the Search Committee appointed by it to recommend three names for the appointment of an incumbent to the Rajiv Gandhi Chair, on Protective Discrimination. The Council however could not make any appointment as the Search Committee did not recommend the panel of 3 (three) names as required under the provision of Clause 7 (iii) of Ordinance OB - 15".

The Executive Council directs the O&L to take up with the Chairman on the above resolution for which this second meeting has been convened.

In this connection - the relevant portions of Ordinance relating to the powers and functions of the Search Committee are also reproduced below for guiding the Members:-

Clause 7(iii) of OB - 15(Ordinance).

The Search Committee shall carry out an exhaustive Search amongst available Indian Scholars within the country and Over-seas for the post and shall recommend a panel of three names to the Executive Council.

The bio-datas of the earlier recommendation alongwith previous copy of recommendation are herewith given to Dy.Registrar (Sri.K.Leb) for handing over to the Chairman at Delhi.
