- (i) Constitution of Selection Committee for recruitment of Scientific Officer in RSIC

It may be recalled that the Executive Council in its 100th meeting, vide resolution No. EC.100.99.6.7. (i) has approved the constitution of the Selection Committee for recruitment of Scientific Officers in RSIC, that at present the Selection Committee may consists of the members as indicated in the resolution at Annexure-'I'. Further, the Council has decided that the practice followed by other Universities/Institutions having RSIC may be obtained and placed before the Council.

With regards to the above decision of the Council, it may be mentioned that the Selection Committee consists of the members as approved by the said Council could not be conducted as the term of the Visitor's nominee has expired, and the University has written to the Ministry to forward the list of fresh nominees, and reply is still awaited.

Secondly, the University had also written to other Universities/Institutions as per the list provided by the Head, RSIC, NEHU, to intimate us about the procedures of constitutions of Selection Committee for recruitment of Scientific Officer in RSIC. In response to our letter, the University had received an information from three institutions/universities viz. RSIC Nagpur, IIT Madras and Punjab University as per letter at Annexure-'II', 'III' and 'IV' respectively. Since the University had received the reply from the three aforesaid institutions/Universities, the informations received from them are placed before the Council as decided in its 100th meeting for consideration of the members to constitute the Selection Committee for recruitment of Scientific Officers of RSIC

EC:104:99:6:7: (ii): This item was taken along with item No.6:2: (xvi): The Council considered the letter received from the UGC regarding banning on creation of Plan and non Plan-posts and filling of vacant posts. The Council considered the Ban but in view of all the difficulties faced by NEHU it is not possible to accept the ban as it stands. The Council suggested that a Committee be appointed to look into the matter, while reiterating its stand on it. The Vice-Chancellor shall constitute the Committee which will also look into the ban on purchase of vehicles.
