(i) TRANSFER OF LAND FOR SETTING UP AN INSTITUTE OF HOTEL MANAGEMENT, CATERING TECHNOLOGY AND APPLIED NUTRITION.

The Government of Meghalaya under the auspices of the Tourism Department has proposed to set up an Institute of Hotel Management, Catering Technology and Applied Nutrition in Shillong as part of Prime Minister's package to the North-East. In order to materialise this project, a land measuring about 20 acres will be required and it has proposed to request the University authority to transfer the land located adjacent to the University's Sports Complex, to the Government of Meghalaya, for the above purpose.

In this respect, it may also be stated that the Commissioner & Secretary (Tourism), Government of Meghalaya vide letter No.IHMCTAN/15/P.Site/00/126 dt. 19.9.2001 has made a request for transfer of the said land enclosing a copy of the No Objection certificate from the Revenue Department, Government of Meghalaya, towards acquiring of the land.(copy enclosed for ready reference).

The Matter is placed before the Council for consideration.
