New Regulation (number to be given)

ON ADMISSION TO FOREIGN STUDENTS

- I. Foreign students seeking admission under **categories A or B** as provided under OC 1(3) shall have to satisfy the minimum eligibility criteria for admission to the various programmes of study as prescribed by the University.

The applicants shall apply in a prescribed form by January every year for the session beginning in August of the same year with an application fee of USD 25/- (Twenty Five US Dollars) payable in favour of the Finance Officer, North Eastern Hill University, Shillong, INDIA.

The admission shall be subject to the following conditions –

1. Equivalence of their qualifications as prescribed by the University for various programmes of study.
2. Health clearance certificate from competent authority of the originating country.
3. Possession of a valid Visa for the purpose
4. Recommendation of the concerned department/centre of North-Eastern Hill University.

II Admission to a department/centre of the university under **category C** as provided under OC 1(3) may be granted admission by the Overseas Students Admission Committee on fulfilling following requirements:

1. Valid visa for the purpose
2. Health clearance certificate from competent authority of the originating country.
3. Recommendation of the concerned department/centre of NEHU.
